Meet in the Lynbrook High School Dance Studio at 5:30 pm for your first Workshop on Monday, April 6th . Please remember to bring your signed Parent/Guardian Permission Slip (Page 12) to the first day of workshops. You will not be able to dance without it. Workshops will last two hours and will run Monday (4/4), Wednesday (4/6), Friday (4/8) and Saturday (4/9). Please wear ALL BLACK , your hair up, slicked back, and pin it out of your face. Come dressed ready to move: dance attire, shorts, sports bras, tank tops are fine, and jazz shoes or half-soles. NO TENNIS SHOES ALLOWED, NO BAGGY CLOTHING, and your hair may not be worn down and in your face. Please do not be late. Check-in time will begin promptly at 5:30pm. On audition day please look presentable and professional, follow the above guidelines for your hair, and wear all black.

Audition Workshop - Additional Information

What to Expect:

- ✓ Warm-ups
- ✓ Across the floor technique/combinations (ex: variety of triple turns, leaps, jumps, etc.)
- ✓ Learn one audition routine of different styles (possibly jazz/contemporary and hip-hop). Audition routines are intermediate/advanced level.
- ✔ Learn Kick technique

What to Wear:

- ✓ Dance clothes: dance pants, leggings, shorts, etc. (No baggy clothing).
- ✓ Jazz shoes must be worn on the dance floor. You must wear shoes, no dancing in socks.
- ✔ Bring sneakers.
- ✓ Have your hair pulled up in a tight ponytail or clean bun (make sure it is pinned out of your face).
- ✓ No jewelry or watches (stud earrings are ok).

What to Bring:

- ✔ Parent/Guardian Permission Slip to the first day of workshops
- ✔ Bottled water
- ✓ Device to play music (Music will be emailed so dancer's can practice the audition routines)
- ✓ A POSITIVE ATTITUDE ⇔

Workshop Rules:

- 1. Cell phones must be turned off during the Workshop sessions
- 2. No food
- 3. No gum
- 4. Be respectful

Letter to Parent/Guardian

Dear Parent/Guardian:

I am pleased that your dancer has applied to be a member of the 2022-2023 Lynbrook High School Dance Team, the "Valkyries." The Lynbrook Dance Team has an established tradition of leadership, commitment, and excellence in school athletics and activities. Dance Team members are highly visible representatives of Lynbrook HS. They learn communication and team skills that will benefit them long after graduation. Many will develop lifelong friendships and participate in events, which become some of the most positive memories of their high school years.

As parents, your dancer's participation on the Dance Team will need not only your approval, but also your support. Time commitments for the Dance Team are substantial. As parents, you may have to provide transportation for competitions or performances outside of the local area.

Attendance at summer dance camp, uniforms, transportation, shoes, warm ups, food and dance competitions all cost money. The estimated total donation requested per team member is approximately \$3,000-3,500, * Fundraising opportunities throughout the year will help offset costs.

There is a **mandatory** parent and student meeting on **Monday**, **March 28**th **at 7:00 pm** via Zoom. Attendance is required to make your dancer eligible for the Dance Team. Therefore, we report costs in terms of total costs and requested voluntary donations. All students are given the opportunity to participate regardless of ability to make a donation. However, aspects of the program may not come to fruition if there are insufficient funds.

Valkyries Dance Team Agreement

Below are the Goal and Objectives, General Rules, and Code of Conduct that you will be expected to abide by as a member of the Lynbrook Valkyries Dance Team.

Please read them closely and email the signed agreement page (Pages 9-11) to the **mandatory** Parent/Student meeting on **Monday**, **March 28**th **at 7:00pm**, via Zoom.

Goals and Objectives

- 1. To support your school and your team, and to promote pride and spirit.
- 2. To perform at games, rallies and competitions as much as possible.
- 3. To serve as positive role models.

General Rules

- 1. In order to try out for a Lynbrook Dance Team position, you must have a minimum GPA of 2.0. If you make the squad, you must maintain a GPA of 2.0 in order to remain eligible for the Dance Team.
 - a. If at the end of a 6-week grading period your grades drop below a 2.0, you will be placed on probation for the next 6 weeks. You may still participate in Dance Team activities.
 - b. If your grades are below a 2.0 at the end of the next 6-week grading period, you are considered academically ineligible. You may not dress in uniform or participate in Dance Team activities.
 - c. If your grades are still below a 2.0 at the end of the next grading period, you will be dismissed from the team.
- 2. Attendance at a USA Dance/Drill camp is strongly recommended. Dance camp is very important for the development of dance skills and team building.
- 3. Attend **all scheduled practices**. Regular practices are normally held on Wednesdays and Fridays somewhere between 3:30pm-8:00pm. Additional practices will be scheduled, normally on Saturday 9:00am-5:00pm. Schedule is subject to change based on the current coach/director's availability.
- 4. Uniforms are part of the dance team experience and are required. Members of the dance team are required to wear the designated uniform or costume for competitions, school events, camps, and other events as designated by the coach.

- 5. Team members typically participate in 5 competitions each year, including State and National Championships.
- 6. Membership in the Dance Team requires a full year commitment at 120% energy.
- 7. All Lynbrook, CIF, DAL rules apply regarding conduct.

Code of Conduct

- 1. Personality conflicts within the team will not be reflected in the team's performance.
- 2. Attitudes toward other campus groups will be one of friendly support.
- 3. As representatives of Lynbrook, Dance Team members are courteous to coaches, faculty, other members of the community, and other dance teams.
- 4. Dance Team members must have the poise and leadership ability, as well as the maturity, to remember who they are and what they represent at all times.
